We are a women led and a youth friendly organization established and registered as National Share Vision South Sudan is a National Non-Government Organization registered with the RRCs office under the registration number 3892 for the year ending September 2023 Organization operating in South Sudan.

We mainly work with the women and youths and we our interventions are in Peace Building and Reconciliation, Climate change, WASH, GBV, Protection, Economic Empowerment and Health.

Shared Vision is as a result of the Civil war in South Sudan that ended in 2016. We have been working with the victims of the civil war help them cope with the trauma. We have formed the Victim support groups, building resilience among them and fighting for the reconciliation of the Many groups that were affected and pointing fingers to each other.

For example, in Magwi County, Eastern Equatoria, we have formed so far 20 support groups and are actively affecting each and resolving the tensions that were still boiling in minds of the community members.

I was supported to be part of the UN-SCO meeting in Nairobi which was a great eye opener on the side of Peace building and Reconciliation.

I truly accept that Peace building and reconciliation is important for all countries but mainly South Sudan where tensions are boiling each day and where there is a lot of tribal conflicts and armed fighting between tribes fueling anger among youths and making most of them hate each other hence civil war.

Since the Nairobi meeting we as shared Vision have picked up Peace Building Education as key mainly to youth in school and out of school.

With time and as we mobilize resources we plan to have Youth in school and out of school peer educators who will e fully trained on the concept of Peace building and reconciliation and will act

as change agents with the different communities and in a long run we will receive peace in South Sudan.
