Today there is a risk of isolation, emotional insecurity and self-centeredness for children, which results in the need for a sense of direction.

The S.E.R Kinderhilfe has therefore made it its goal to encourage children with different cultural backgrounds to take part in creative activities. They can relax and enjoy the exploration of their talents, and be surprised by the talents of others.

In tinkering, pottering, singing and playing in their own playground a supportive togetherness is encouraged. Thus a practise of resolving conflicts peacefully, being tolerant and integrating into a community is promoted. This sometimes opens up completely casual discussions on meaning and the question of values. The effective development of leisure and training of conflict skills help the children to get more stability in their every-day-life.

Two volunteers each look after 6 to 8 children in the afternoon. Participation for the children is free.

Discussions with parents and teachers make clear how important and useful this work is. It is also very good, that the schools, which the children attend in the morning, are excluded so that these hours are not trimmed to learning, too.
